ECAC DOC 30, Part1, Section 5, Annex 5 – L Guidance Material has been created to provide a tool for the National Enforcement Bodies (NEBs) to make an assessment of progress at airports in implementing the requirements and good practice in meeting the needs of passengers with disabilities and Persons with Reduced Mobility in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1107/2006 concerning the rights of disabled persons with reduced mobility when travelling by air, and it's interpretive guidelines (SWD (2012) 171, 11 June 2012), and the recommendations made in ECAC Doc 30 and its annexes, 12th edition/May 2018.

Part of this Annex contains a checklist to verify that all items have been covered during the NEB audit and to make notes about the findings. The material for the airports includes audit document phase and on-site audit phase.
